WHISPERING PINES CIRCULATION COORDINATOR

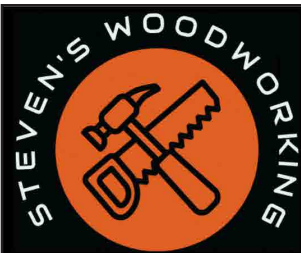

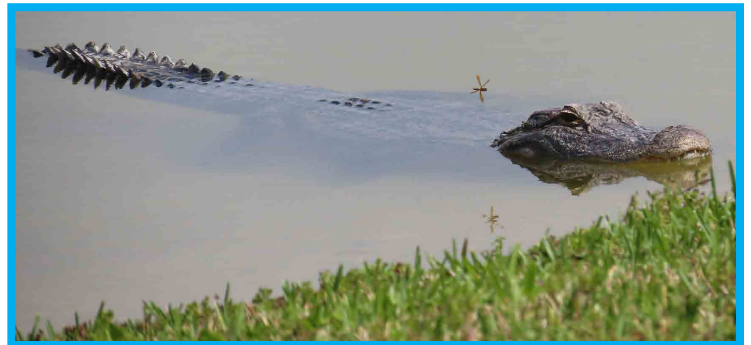

MAINTENANCE ISSUES

1) Status of rubberized mats for the Eagle Trace bridge.

Response: Mats are scheduled for delivery today, 4/8. Rubberized mat will be tested on the Friendship bridge first before installation on the main bridge.

2) Status of new bridge lights at Eagle Trace.

Response: Lights are on backorder.

3) Status of corrections on the facility direction and golf course signs.

Response: Quote has been provided and the corrections will be addressed once they begin updating the signage for the golf course; will focus only on essential signage.

4) Status of the pool fountain.

Response: Pool fountain is now working; there was a leak in the manifold that has been repaired. Fountain has been off for the last few days due to the high winds.

5) Has fence on west side of property been patched?

Response: It is on the work schedule; maintenance staff is catching up on several projects.

6) Have tiles been installed in the Pub bathrooms?

Response: Yes, the work is mostly completed, contingent on the women's vanity being installed and some minor touch ups. Both bathrooms are now open.

Ask that residents show respect for updates made to facilities.

7) Cul-de-sac number signs are getting harder to read and need to be replaced.

Response: Signage is being addressed, in process with other signage.

8) Problem with hot water at the outside kitchen.

5) The garbage can by Indigo was removed after animals got into it; will it be replaced or not?

ARC DISCUSSION AND UPDATES

Vianney distributed the architectural log that she is keeping. She has also prepared a sign when projects are approved, the sign should be displayed to show that project has been approved (for neighbors). Vianney has a yellow form that is posted visibly on the home. Will log be distributed at every Liaison meeting?

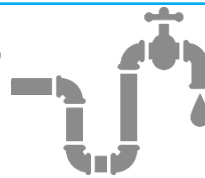

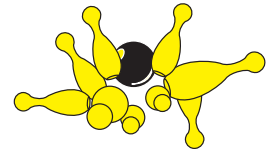

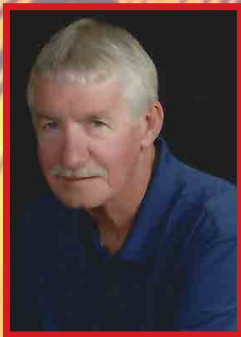
